## The power of the painted line

Julie Goldenberg has always approached her art practice with an innate sense of freedom to do what interests her, both technically and with content. Her distinctive individual style of painting relies strongly on drawing. When the sensibility and vitality of the painted line meets the intensity of colour, a powerful and dynamic energy is created. She explores the female figure but boundaries between male and female are blurred. Her approach to dealing with sexuality and her new role of mother in her art are refreshingly direct.

Julie is a Western Australian artist who has exhibited in Perth, Sydney, Melbourne and Germany. She has received a number of commissions including a Festival of Perth poster. Her work is held in public and private collections in Australia and overseas.

The exhibition **New Paintings** runs from **12 April – 3 May 2008**. Opening drinks will be on Saturday 12 April from 3-5 pm. The artist will be present.
